

THE SMITHTOWN LIBRARY INTERNET POLICY

The Suffolk Cooperative Library System, acting administrator of the Internet project, reserves the right to:

1. Remove the account of any user who does not adhere to the acceptable use policy.
2. Remove any account which has not been used in six months.
3. Notify any user that he is using a disproportionate share of disk space and that his immediate downloading or deletion of files is necessary.
4. Delete files from any user's account if that user, once notified, has failed to clean his directory within one week of notification.

The library assumes no responsibility for any damage which may occur as a result of the use of this system. This may include, but is not limited to, loss of data resulting from delays, non-deliveries, or service interruptions, as well as damages resulting from unintended transfers or disclosures of user file information. Be aware that access to computers worldwide brings with it access to material which may be considered inappropriate for some users. It is up to the user to determine what is appropriate.
