

Getting Started with Livebrary.com Free Downloads for Kindle Users

Did you know you can download free eBooks to your KIndle ereader, Fire tablet or Kindle App and audiobooks to your Fire tablet? All you need is a valid Smithtown Library card and internet access to get started. You're allowed to check out up to seven titles at a time, for up to 21 days. Titles are returned automatically, so there are no overdue books and no late fees!

GETTING STARTED

- 1. Go to The Smithtown Library's homepage at <u>www.smithlib.org</u> and click on eBooks, Audiobooks and More. Scroll down and click View Libby to open the Livebrary.com catalog.
- Click on Sign In in the upper right corner. Select Smithtown Library from the drop-down list. Enter your barcode or username and your library card password and click on Sign In. Don't have a password yet? Click on Password Help. An email address in your library record is required for this step.
- Click on My Account and select Settings. Set your lending periods for up to 21 days for eBooks and audiobooks. Click History to keep a list of the titles you have borrowed. Select what type(s) of content you prefer with the audience filters. If you will only be using a Kindle, you can select Kindle Preference.
- 4. On a Kindle Paperwhite or other Kindle eReader, use a computer or other internet source to search, borrow and select your device as explained below and the title will download via WiFi. With a Kindle Fire you can complete this process in the Silk browser on your Fire tablet or download the Libby App and follow the instructions for Libby.

SEARCHING & BROWSING

- 1. To browse for eBooks, click on Kindle Books and use the filters on the left. Or click on Collections and select a category under eBooks or Audiobooks. You can also browse the homepage, or click on Subjects and select a topic. For 7 day loans of popular titles, try It's Your Lucky Day!
- 2. To search for a specific title or author, click on the magnifying glass icon in the upper right corner. Enter a title or author's name, or a combination of title and author.
- 3. Your search results will include both eBooks and audiobooks. Look for the icons below the book covers to show you what formats are available.

- 4. Click on a book cover for more information, or click the link below the cover to borrow or place a hold. Available titles can be borrowed immediately. To place a hold, enter your email address. You will be notified by email when the book becomes available.
- 5. Once you've borrowed a title, select Read now with Kindle and you'll be taken to Amazon.com.
- 6. Sign in with your email address and Amazon.com password. On the far right, select a device or Kindle app from the drop-down list and click Get Library Book. The Kindle Book will be delivered to your device or Kindle app the next time you connect to WiFi. If you are already connected to WiFi, you may need to Sync your device for the book to download.
- 7. The Kindle Book will remain on your device for the loan period you selected (7 days, 14 days or 21 days). At the end of the loan period, the Kindle Book will expire and be returned automatically.
- 8. You're not required to return eBooks, but if you reach your checkout limit you may wish to return an eBook before it expires. To return eBooks early, go to your Loans page and click on the Return icon under the title.

TIPS & TRICKS

- 1. Create a wish list of titles you'd like to read in the future. Click on the bookmark icon in the lower right corner on any book cover to save the title to your wish list. View your wish list by going to My Account and then Wish List.
- 2. Search for a popular author like James Patterson and you may get too many results. Limit your search using the filters on the left. First, select eBook or audiobook. Then, select Available Now to hide all checked out titles. Click on Date added to see the newest titles first.
