The 2024 Budget

The Library Board's goal is to adopt a budget that is balanced with an emphasis on service, resources and fiscal prudence.

Who Can Vote?

Smithtown Special Library District residents who are registered to vote with the Suffolk County Board of Elections.

Voter Registration

Voter registration forms and information can be obtained through the Suffolk County Board of Elections, the post office or any Smithtown Library Building.

Absentee Voting

Smithtown Library Absentee Ballot Applications are available at all Smithtown Library Buildings and the Library's website.

Library Trustee Candidate Information

The Smithtown Library Board of Trustees will have four (4) seats, of a seven seat Board, up for election this year. Two seats will possess the standard three-year term commencing on January 1, 2024 and ending December 31, 2026. The remaining two seats are currently being served by interim appointees due to the resignations of previously elected Trustees. Therefore, the candidates who are elected to these two seats will serve the remainder of the terms - October 11, 2023 through December 31, 2024.

Per the statute that governs the Smithtown Special Library District, no vacancy on the Board is considered to be a separate specific office. Therefore, the number of votes a candidate garners will determine the length of his/her term. The highest two receivers of votes will serve the standard 3-year terms. The 3rd and 4th highest receivers of votes will serve from October 11, 2023 through December 31, 2024.

Las solicitudes de boleta de voto en ausencia de la biblioteca de Smithtown están disponibles en todos los edificios de la biblioteca de Smithtown y en el sitio web de la biblioteca.

Biblioteca Fiduciario candidato información

La Junta Directiva de la Biblioteca Smithtown tendrá cuatro (4) puestos, de una Junta de siete puestos, que se elegirá este año. Dos puestos poseerán el mandato estándar de tres años que comenzará el 1 de enero de 2024 y finalizará el 31 de diciembre de 2026. Los dos puestos restantes actualmente están siendo ocupados por personas designadas interinamente debido a las renuncias de los Fideicomisarios elegidos previamente. Por lo tanto, los candidatos elegidos para estos dos escaños cumplirán el resto del mandato: del 11 de octubre de 2023 al 31 de diciembre de 2024.

Según el estatuto que rige el Distrito de Bibliotecas Especiales de Smithtown, ninguna vacante en la Junta se considera un cargo específico separado. Por lo tanto, el número de votos que obtenga un candidato determinará la duración de su mandato. Los dos receptores con mayor número de votos cumplirán los mandatos estándar de 3 años. El tercer y cuarto mayor receptor de votos desempeñarán sus funciones desde el 11 de octubre de 2023 hasta el 31 de diciembre de 2024.
