

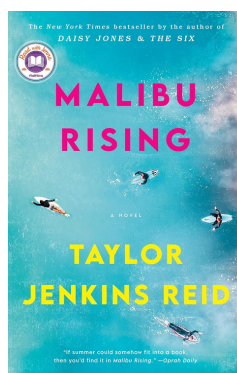

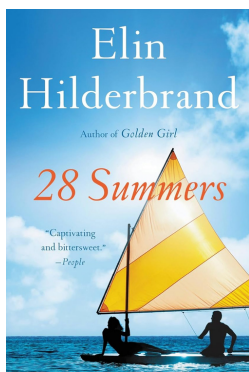
How Stella Got Her Groove Back by Terry McMillan

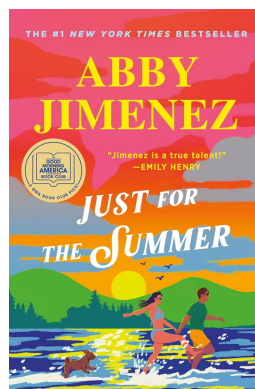
The Vacationers by Emma Straub
