## POLICIES OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The Board of Trustees is a legislative body: its resolutions have the force of law.

Policies may be repealed, amended, or added to by a majority vote of the whole Board at a regular meeting. Such action may be taken, however, only after the substance of the proposed repeal, amendment, or addition has been presented in writing at a prior regular meeting and notice thereof has been given in the notice of the meeting at which it is to be considered. Policies should be reviewed for possible revision annually by a Bylaws and Policy Committee. Policies can be reviewed at any time if determined by simple majority of the Board

All Policies repealed, amended or created by the Board will be collected from the minute book and incorporated as changes in the Policy Handbook by the next regular meeting.

The Director is charged with the responsibility of reviewing policies when necessary, suggesting changes in current policies and presenting this information to the Board for review.

It must be clearly understood that the Board of Trustees is the policy-making organization of the Library and is free to exercise judgment and render a decision.
