Dennis Cannataro Family Summer Concert Series Returns



After a two year hiatus, the **Dennis Cannataro Family Summer Concert Serie**s returned to the front lawn of the Smithtown Building on July 7 with a performance by **Just Sixties**. CALCULATING YOUR TAX: The library tax rate is expressed as dollars and cents per \$1,000 of assessed valuation. The tax rate is estimated at 62.693 per \$1,000 assessed valuation; an average house assessed at \$6,000 would pay an annual library tax of \$376.16, an increase of \$8.19 per year (69¢ per month).

Example: 6,000 assessed value \div 1,000 = 66 x 62.693 tax rate = 376.16 annual library tax

El tipo impositivo se estima en 62.693 por valoración evaluada de \$1,000 dólares; una casa promedio evaluada en \$6,000 pagaría un impuesto anual de la biblioteca de \$376.16, un aumento de \$8.19 por año (69¢ por mes).


